Students who apply must be residents of the Town of Columbia at the time of application and have demonstrated a commitment to public service.

Completed applications must be submitted to the office of the Columbia Superintendent of Schools by 4:00 p.m. Tuesday, April 18, 2017.

Applications are evaluated by a scholarship committee appointed by the Superintendent and winners are notified by that office.
