**BABY SITTING SAFETY:  
CPR AND FIRST AID FOR YOUNG CAREGIVERS (GRADES 5-12)**

This course is designed for young caregivers. Guidelines and standards of the American Heart Association are followed during CPR & Choking and Basic First Aid demonstrations and skill practice. Mannequins are used for hands-on practice. Basic information on caregiver responsibilities and how to care, handle, feed and change infants and children will be discussed, demonstrated and practiced. Police and fire safety topics, including an overview of the 911 system and when to access it in an emergency, will also be discussed.
